Grads must initial each line of expected behaviors:

- _____ I understand I need to check in at ORHS Small Gym by 10:30 pm – 11:15 pm on Friday, May 29th, 2020
- _____ I understand **NO** food or drink is allowed to be brought in to ORHS small gym during check-in other than the food and drink provided by ORHS Grad Night (**this includes WATER BOTTLES, GUM AND MINTS**)
- _____ I will **not** leave the ORHS small gym after check-in until released to board the bus. **No re-admits allowed.**
- _____ I will **not** consume or bring alcohol, tobacco, or any other drugs to Grad Night.
- _____ I will **not** bring medications of any kind (including Tylenol or Advil) to Grad Night
- (A written note from parent/guardian must accompany any medications and ONLY BRING THE AMOUNT NEEDED FOR THE TRIP!)**
- _____ I **will** abide by the Disney dress code for Grad Night events - "All apparel must be in good condition (excessively ripped or torn jeans, shirts, etc. are prohibited) and revealing clothing not allowed.
" Think Family Friendly"
- _____ **I agree and understand that I will not leave Disneyland, California Adventure, or Downtown Disney for any reason.**
- _____ I agree and understand that I must return to my original bus by 11:30 PM on Saturday, May 30th, 2020.
- _____ I agree and understand that **I am responsible** for being **ON TIME** to catch my bus.
(There will be a short grace period, and then the buses will leave.)
- _____ Grad Night chaperones are **not responsible** for lost or stolen items.
- _____ I agree if I get in trouble with Disney Police and/or break any rules of this contract, I will not be allowed to ride on the bus back to Oak Ridge High School. Transportation home will be the responsibility of you and your parents.

Grads and parent/guardian must initial acknowledgement of consequences for any breach of expected behaviors:

- _____ Grads may be required to sit with a Grad Night chaperon on a "Disney Detention" until it is Time to depart Disneyland.
- _____ Grad's parent/guardian may be called to pick up the student in Anaheim, CA for breaches of expected behaviors.
- _____ Transportation to and from ORHS High School (1120 Harvard Way, El Dorado Hills, CA) will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. **Grads MAY NOT drive themselves to and from ORHS.** There will be no exceptions. Pick up is Approximately 6:30 - 7 AM on Sunday morning.
- _____ Grad Night is an alcohol, drug and tobacco free party. ORHS Grad Night is a "Zero Tolerance" event. If Grads are in possession of or suspected to be under the influence of alcohol, tobacco or drugs, they will be denied entry and it will be the responsibility of their parents or guardians to pick up students, and /or counseled by local law enforcement.
- _____ If my senior is not following the set guidelines, I as a parent will be required to pick them up at any time along the way of the trip and/or if my senior goes to Disney Jail or Anaheim jail, I will be required to pick them up even if they are 18 years of age. In this case, the senior will be immediately dismissed from the event and will not be allowed to return on the ORHS Grad Night buses, and no refunds will be given.

FOR GRADS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

Please read carefully:

All Grad Night Grads age 18 or older must agree to policies stated herein and affirm their understanding and agreement by their signature at the end of this form.

- I agree to cooperate and comply with all reasonable directions and instructions from Grad Night's chaperons.
- In the event of an emergency, I give permission to ORHS Grad Night, and representatives, and adult volunteers, to arrange for and authorize emergency medical, dental, or surgical treatment for me, as considered necessary by the attending physician.
- I agree to be responsible for all medical expenses relating to my injury as a result of participation in ORHS Grad Night, whether or not caused by the negligence of the school volunteers or other participants.
- I understand that in the course of participating in ORHS Grad Night, I may engage in an activity that carries a risk of injury to the body, psyche, or property of themselves and others. Such activities caused by other persons, may be accidental or self-inflicted, or may arise from faulty equipment or facilities, existing conditions of recreational facilities, vehicle accidents while in transport of an activity, or the activity itself.
- If I am not following the guidelines, I understand my parent will be required to pick me up at any time along the way of the trip and/or if I go to Disney Jail or Anaheim jail, my parents will be required to pick me up even if I am 18 years of age. In this case, I will be immediately dismissed from the event and will not be allowed to return on the ORHS Grad Night buses, and no refunds will be given.

Accordingly, in consideration for being permitted to participate in the activities of ORHS Grad Night, to use the equipment provided, and to enter the premises and facilities of the ORHS High School, and Disneyland for any purpose including observation of and participation in activities, the undersigned Grads agrees as follows:

1. To release, waive, discharge, and promise not to sue ORHS Grad Night and its affiliated entities, agents, and volunteers, ORHS High School, Disneyland or any of their facilities or equipment.
2. To indemnify and hold harmless ORHS Grad Night & ORHS school, and Disneyland from any loss, liability, damage, or cost it may incur due to my presence in, upon, or about the ORHS School, or Disneyland or their facilities or equipment, or while participating in any ORHS Grad Night activities whether caused by the negligence of ORHS Grad Night, ORHS High School, or Disneyland or otherwise.

- I/We give permission for my/our minor child to be transported to and from Disneyland by chartered bus.

ORHS Grad Night & Disneyland Senior Contract

My son/daughter (listed below) will be attending ORHS Grad Night at Disneyland Resorts on May 29-31, 2020. We understand that certain rules and regulations will be in effect during the duration of the trip and while at Disneyland Resorts. As a parent, I agree to advise my son/daughter of such rules and regulations prior to the ORHS Grad Night Disneyland Resorts trip.

As a graduating senior, I will abide by the ORHS Grad Night & Disneyland Resorts rules and guidelines of the trip. If a senior arrives under the influence or brings prohibited items, they will be asked to leave, will not be able to attend the event, and will not receive a refund. If a senior is not following the guidelines, I as a parent will be required to pick them up at any time along the way of the trip and/or if my senior goes to Disney Jail or Anaheim jail, I will be required to pick them up even if they are 18 years of age. In this case, the senior will be immediately dismissed from the event and will not be allowed to return on the ORHS Grad Night buses, and no refunds will be given.

Items to be turned in during Senior Breakfast:

Backpack, Large Clear Plastic Bag including small blanket and pillow (with your first & last name and cell # on the bag), Cell phone charger, Sweatshirt, personal hygiene items, sunscreen, empty water bottle, comfortable walking shoes, medications prescribed by a doctor and/or approved by ORHS Grad Night Coordinator.

GRADS – Please **DO NOT** include the **clothes/shoes** you plan to wear on the bus in your backpacks.

You will not be allowed access to your backpack until you are boarding the buses.

Items allowed to bring when checking into the Small Gym:

1. School ID & Driver's License (a photo ID is required at small gym check in and at Disneyland Resorts)
2. Money/credit & ATM cards for spending
3. Cell phones

DO NOT bring anything else to the Small Gym Check-In!

No purses! No Yearbooks! No Backpacks! You will have to call your parents to pick them up!

Seniors will not have access to buses during the day while in the Disney Resorts.

Personal items can be left on the buses while at the Disney parks. Less is best!

Prohibited items:

All students will be searched prior to entering into the Disneyland Resorts. And Disneyland has K-9 Dogs to search for illegal drugs as you enter through the screening process and within the Disney parks.

Selfie Sticks
Glass Containers

All types of markers and highlighters
Alcoholic beverages and any illegal substances

Disneyland Resorts Rules on smoking:

As of May 1, 2019, the Theme parks and Downtown Disney will become smoke free.

Weapons of any kind
Self-defense equipment
Restraining devices
Disruptive items

No smoking of marijuana (including medical) or
illegal substances, no tobacco, e-cigarettes or
other products that produce vapor or smoke is
allowed.

Disneyland Resorts Inappropriate Attire

Attire that is not appropriate for the theme parks (and which may result in refusal of admittance or ejection) includes but is not limited to:

- Costumes may not be worn by Guests 14 years of age or older
- Masks may not be worn by Guests 14 years of age or older (unless they are for medical purposes)
- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics
- Excessively torn clothing or loose-fitting clothing which may drag on the ground and create a potential trip hazard
- **Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment**
- Clothing with multiple layers are subject to search upon entry
- Visible tattoos that could be considered inappropriate, such as those containing objectionable language or designs
- Bare feet

I also expressly consent that my son/daughter may be subject of a pat down search by local law enforcement and/or a Disney Cast member at any given time during the stay at the Disneyland Resorts. **Dress Code: I will abide by the dress code of the Disneyland Resorts THINK “FAMILY FRIENDLY”**

\$15 fee for Disney FASTPASS & Photo Pass Service

Mobile App – Enhance your next visit to Disneyland Park or Disney California Adventure Park with the official Disneyland Resort mobile app. See wait times, browse maps, locate Disney Characters, make and redeem digital Disney FASTPASS selections while you're in the parks on the day of your visit with the new Disney MaxPass feature—and much more!

Disney FASTPASS Service – This service lets you reserve your place in line for popular attractions while you enjoy other areas of the parks. Take advantage of the service by either purchasing the Disney MaxPass feature (\$15 per day, per ticket) so you can conveniently make FASTPASS selections using your mobile device—or by visiting FASTPASS Distribution points near select attractions to retrieve entitlements at no extra charge. Guests are strongly advised to check the day's FASTPASS availability and other park details on the Disneyland app before purchasing Disney MaxPass. FASTPASS selections for popular attractions may not be available at the time of Disney MaxPass purchase as FASTPASS selections are limited and availability is not guaranteed.*

Disney Photopic Service (included with theme park admission) – Let Disney PhotoPass Photographers capture great vacation moments for you—and get everyone in the picture! You'll be able to download, share and save all of your photos taken during your visit when you purchase Disney PhotoPass+ One Week or the Disney MaxPass feature.** Be sure to ask the photographers if they have “Magic Shots” on their cameras, they can insert characters in your photos to make it a bit more fun.

MCDONALDS – **Download the McDonalds App on your phone.** Before arriving at McDonalds in Anaheim, order your breakfast if you want to save time from standing in line. We are “scheduled” to stop at McDonalds at Approx. 6:00 -6:30 am on Saturday, May 30th. The location of the McDonalds is 440 N Euclid Street, Anaheim, CA 92801.
