

ORHS Grad Night & Disneyland Senior Contract

My son/daughter (listed below) will be attending ORHS Grad Night at Disneyland Resorts on May 27-29, 2022.. We understand that certain rules and regulations will be in effect during the duration of the trip and while at Disneyland Resorts. As a parent, I agree to advise my son/daughter of such rules and regulations prior to the ORHS Grad Night Disneyland Resorts trip.

As a graduating senior, I will abide by the ORHS Grad Night & Disneyland Resorts rules and guidelines of the trip. If a senior arrives under the influence of alcohol and/or illegal drugs or bring prohibited items, they will be asked to leave, will not be able to attend the event, and will not receive a refund. If a senior is not following the guidelines, I as a parent will be required to pick them up at any time along the way of the trip and/or if my senior goes to Disney Jail or Anaheim jail, I will be required to pick them up even if they are 18 years of age. In this case, the senior will be immediately dismissed from the event and will not be allowed to return on the ORHS Grad Night buses, and no refunds will be given.

Items to be turned in during Senior Breakfast:

Backpack, Large Clear Plastic Bag including small blanket and pillow (with your first & last name and cell # on the bag), Cell phone charger, Sweatshirt, personal hygiene items, sunscreen, empty water bottle, comfortable walking shoes, medications prescribed by a doctor and/or approved by ORHS Grad Night Coordinator.

GRADS – Please **DO NOT** include the **clothes/shoes** you plan to wear on the bus in your backpacks. You will not be allowed access to your backpack until you are boarding the buses.

Items allowed to bring when checking into the Small Gym:

1. School ID & Driver's License (a photo ID is required at small gym check in and at Disneyland Resorts)
2. Money/credit & ATM cards for spending
3. Cell phones

DO NOT bring anything else to the Small Gym Check-In!

No purses! No Yearbooks! No Backpacks! You will have to call your parents to pick them up!

Seniors will not have access to buses during the day while in the Disney Resorts.

Personal items can be left on the buses while at the Disney parks. Less is best!

Prohibited items:

All students will be searched prior to entering into the Disneyland Resorts. Disneyland has K-9 Dogs to search for illegal drugs as you enter through the screening process and within the Disney parks.

Selfie Sticks
Glass Containers
All types of markers and highlighters
Alcoholic beverages and any illegal substances
Weapons of any kind
Self-defense equipment
Restraining devices
Disruptive items

Disneyland Resorts Rules on smoking:

As of May 1, 2019, the Theme parks and Downtown Disney will become smoke free. No smoking of marijuana (including medical) or illegal substances, no tobacco, e-cigarettes or other products that produce vapor or smoke are not allowed.

Additional Helpful Information

Disneyland Resorts Inappropriate Attire

Attire that is not appropriate for the theme parks (and which may result in refusal of admittance or ejection) includes but is not limited to:

- Costumes may not be worn by Guests 14 years of age or older
- Masks may not be worn by Guests 14 years of age or older (unless they are for medical purposes)
- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics
- Excessively torn clothing or loose-fitting clothing which may drag on the ground and create a potential trip hazard
- **Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment**
- Clothing with multiple layers are subject to search upon entry
- Visible tattoos that could be considered inappropriate, such as those containing objectionable language or designs
- Bare feet

I also expressly consent that my son/daughter may be subject of a pat down search by local law enforcement and/or a Disney Cast member at any given time during the stay at the Disneyland Resorts.

Dress Code: I will abide by the dress code of the Disneyland Resorts THINK “FAMILY FRIENDLY”
